

TAKE NOTICE!

PERCABEL BENDOVER, deserted from the Loyal American Regiment of foot, October 6, 1777, commanded by Col. Beverley Robinson and Captain Joshua Barnes' company, quartered at Fort Montgomery, NY, 27 Years of age, 5 feet, 11 inches high, light complexion, Blonde Hair, Blue eyes, had on when deserted purple coat, lavender waistcoat, purple trousers; born in London, England. By trade a fop inlisted by Captain Barnes at Stony Point, NY, October 5, 1777.

Whoever secures the said deserter, so as he may be brought to justice, having been guilty of perjury and sodomy and defrauded his Colonel shall receive from the commanding officer of the said regiment, at headquarters, or of the Agent to the said regiment, at his house at Bloomingdale, NY the sum of 1 shilling over and above what is allowed by act of parliament.

It is requested that all well-wishers of his Majesty's arms, to cause a copy of this advertisement to be posted at the most public place or bawdy house.
