

# TAKE NOTICE!

DENNIS COLLINS, deferted from the Loyal American Regiment of foot, August 20, 1777, commanded by Col. Beverley Robinfon and Captain Wilmont's company, quartered at New York City, 19 Years of age, 5 feet, 6 inches high, light complexion, Dark Brown Hair, Green eyes, had on when deferted green coat, white waift coat, white troufers; born at Peekskill in the county of Duchefs, NY. By trade a farmer inlifted by Captain Wilmont at New York City the 23rd day of March 1777.

Whoever fecures the faid deferter, fo as he may be brought to juftice, having been guilty of perjury and defrauded his Colonel fhall receive from the commanding officer of the faid regiment, at headquarters, or of the Agent to the faid regiment, at his houfe at Kingsbridge NY the fum of 15 fhillings over and above what is allowed by act of parliament.

It is requested that all well-wifhers of his Majefty's arms, to caufe a copy of this advertifement to be pofted at the moft public place.
