

# TAKE NOTICE!

SERJEANT WILLIAM HAIGHT, deserted from the Loyal American Regiment of foot, September 15, 1778, commanded by Col. Beverley Robinson and Captain Randle's company, quartered at New York City, 20 Years of age, 5 feet, 8 inches high, light complexion, Light Brown Hair, Brown eyes, had on when deserted green coat, white waist coat, white trousers; born at Fishkill in the county of Westchester, NY. By trade a cooper enlisted by Captain Randle at Bloomingdale, NY.

Whoever secures the said deserter, so as he may be brought to justice, having been guilty of perjury and defrauded his Colonel shall receive from the commanding officer of the said regiment, at headquarters, or of the Agent to the said regiment, at his house at Kingsbridge NY the sum of 20 shillings over and above what is allowed by act of parliament.

It is requested that all well-wishers of his Majesty's arms, to cause a copy of this advertisement to be posted at the most public place.
