JOHN MOSHER, deserted from the Loyal American Regiment of foot, August 6, 1779, commanded by Col. Beverley Robinson and Captain Joshua Barnes' company, quartered at Kingsbridge, NY, 17 Years of age, 5 feet, 5 inches high, light complexion, Dark Brown Hair, Brown eyes, had on when deserted red coat, white waist coat, white trousers; born in the county of Westchester, NY. By trade a farmer enlisted by Captain Barnes at Kingsbridge, NY, August 2, 1779.

Whoever secures the said deserter, so as he may be brought to justice, having been guilty of perjury and defrauded his Colonel shall receive from the commanding officer of the said regiment, at headquarters, or of the Agent to the said regiment, at his house at Bloomingdale, NY the sum of 5 shillings over and above what is allowed by act of parliament.

It is requested that all well-wishers of his Majesty's arms, to cause a copy of this advertisement to be posted at the most public place.
