

By Order of the Commandant

The following Prices and Assize of Bread are to take place from and after Friday the 9th instant, and to continue until further orders :

SHIP BREAD of the best quality, £ 3 10s. per Cwt.

All LOAF BREAD to weigh TWO POUNDS each Loaf, for FOURTEEN COPPERS.

No Baker or Retailer of Bread shall ask, demand, or receive any greater sum, either for Ship or Loaf Bread, than the Prices above mentioned. All Bread to be marked as heretofore directed, and to be made GOOD.

Such as shall be found either defective in quality, or deficient in weight, shall be forfeited to the Alms-House ; and any person who shall demand or receive any more or greater sum than is above mentioned, either for Loaf or Ship Bread, shall forfeit FIVE POUNDS over and above the value of the Bread so sold, the one half to the Informer, and the other half to be applied to the use of the Poor of this city.
