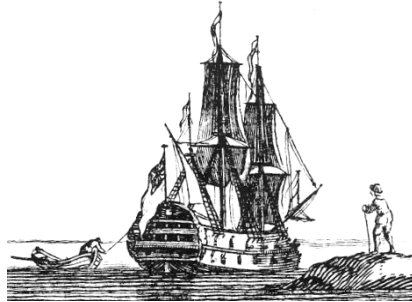


# The Frigate RESTORATION
